Kasper Bartholdy is a Managing Director in the Investment Banking division of Credit Suisse and is based in London. He is the Head of Macro-Analysis for the Emerging Markets Group in the Fixed Income Division.

Mr. Bartholdy joined Credit Suisse First Boston (CSFB) in January 1997 and became a Managing Director in 2001. He left CSFB in 2003 to work as a portfolio manager in EMSO, Citigroup's EM hedge fund, before returning to CSFB in May 2005.

Before his initial stint at CSFB he was Lead Economist at the EBRD in London (1991-1996), Country Economist at the IMF in Washington DC (1986-1991), and Management Consultant at Bisballe in Denmark (1984-1986).

Mr. Bartholdy holds degrees in Economics (M.A.) and Computer Science from the University of Copenhagen. He also holds a degree from the Danish University of Journalism in Aarhus.
