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GUILLERMO ABOUMRAD Santander

GERARDO RODRIGUEZ BlackRock

Gerardo Rodriguez, Managing Director, is Portfolio Manager for Emerging Markets (EM) in the Systematic Active Equity group. His responsibilities include the management of equity and fixed income portfolios, the development of EM products and the oversight of the EM Platform at BlackRock.

Mr. Rodriguez joined BlackRock in 2013 after more than 14 years in the Mexican Ministry of Finance where he last served as Undersecretary of Finance and Public Credit. He has extensive experience in macroeconomic policy, financial market development and infrastructure investments. As Undersecretary, he oversaw the development and regulation of the local financial system and the international affairs of the Ministry of Finance. Before being appointed Undersecretary, he worked in the Ministry of Finance as the Head of Public Debt Management from 2005 to 2011, where his main responsibilities included the extension of the local yield curve, the design of the cetesdirecto platform and the creation of the National Infrastructure Fund.

Mr. Rodriguez earned a BS degree in economics from Universidad de las Americas-Puebla (Mexico) and an MSc in Engineering-Economic Systems and Operations Research from Stanford University.

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ALBERTO RAMOS Goldman Sachs

Alberto is head of the Latin America Economic Research team in the Global Investment Research Division. He joined Goldman Sachs in 2003 as a vice president and was named managing director in 2009.

Prior to joining the firm, Alberto was a senior economist at the International Monetary Fund in Washington, DC, for six years and worked with Argentina, Brazil and Turkey, researching issues related to debt sustainability, fiscal-monetary dominant regimes and sovereign debt restructurings. His written work has been published in the *Journal of Applied Economics*, IMF Working Papers, and Issues in Financial Regulation, a series of the Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago, among others.

Alberto earned an MA and PhD in Economics, specializing in finance, money and banking, from The University of Chicago. He has also taught economics and finance at The University of Chicago and the Universidade Católica Portuguesa in Lisbon, Portugal.

Alberto was born in Mozambique, previously lived in Portugal, and resides in Manhattan.

His funds were also recognized by Morningstar Japan as "Fund of the Year" on several occasions.

Prior to joining Nomura, he was at TCW, where he worked as a trader and assistant portfolio manager. He believes the best opportunities in the asset class are identified through a combination of bottom-up research, an assessment of macro factors, and an understanding of how EM issuers trade in relation to global credit markets.
