Terrence Main's work is now in the collections of the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the Brooklyn Museum of Art and the Cranbrook Academy of Art Museum, among others, and has been featured in numerous publications and exhibits worldwide, including: Modern Furniture, The Metropolitan Museum (1994); Art and Application, Turbulence NY (1993); and Guerillas, Art et Industrie NY (1997).

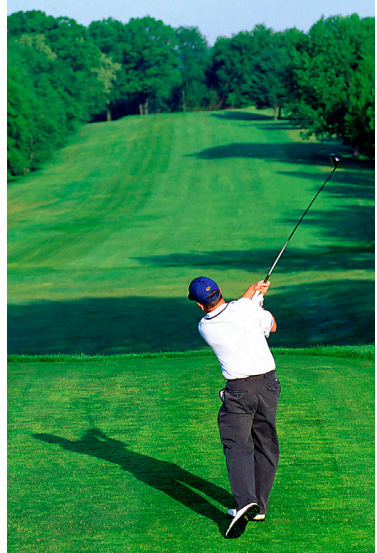

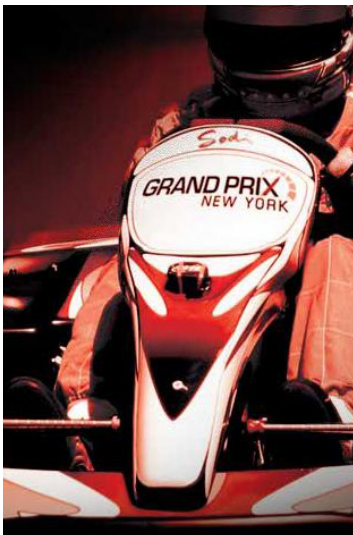

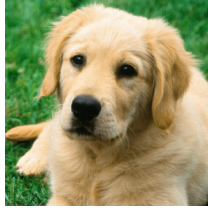
